Application due: April 1, 2020

Who is eligible?

All Richland County 4-H members who:

- a) Are in 7th-8th grade (Junior 4-H Ambassadors must have completed one year in 4-H) or Are in 9th-12th grade (4-H Ambassadors must have 2 or more years of 4-H experience).
- b) Are approved by their 4-H Club Leader as good representatives of the Richland County 4-H Youth Development Program.
- c) Agree to meet the expectations of the program. (see "What are your responsibilities" on page 2)
- d) Agree to participate in and complete the Richland County 4-H Ambassador Orientation.

What will YOU get out of the program?

- 1. Be recognized as a 4-H teen who has achieved high standards of excellence in your 4-H program or project work, in citizenship, and in leadership.
- 2. Opportunities and experiences to enhance your knowledge, skills, attitudes, and aspirations in leadership, citizenship, communications and public relations, scholarship, and related areas of interest and need.
- 3. Serve as spokespersons in order to develop and strengthen 4-H partnerships with government officials, the media, state associations, donors, civic groups, parents, volunteers, and others.
- 4. Meaningful opportunities to be actively involved and valued as equal partners in defining, developing, implementing, diversifying, and improving 4-H youth development in Richland County.
- 5. Be involved in expanding 4-H marketing and promotion efforts and manage the Richland County 4-H image to ensure compatibility with our vision, mission, and values.

The Richland County 4-H Ambassador program recognizes teens for standards of excellence and leadership in 4-H. All Richland County 4-H teens who have achieved excellence in 4-H work, 4-H participation, 4-H citizenship, 4-H leadership, 4-H officer/committee work, and other non-4-H leadership are invited to apply for a position on the Richland County 4-H Ambassador Team.

Being a Richland County 4-H Ambassador is both a tremendous honor and an important responsibility.

What are your responsibilities?

4-H Ambassadors will be expected to:

- 1. Actively participate in the 4-H Ambassador program
- 2. Maintain high standards of excellence related to the 4-H pledge commitments of:
 - a. Clear thinking
 - b. Great loyalty
 - c. Large service
 - d. Better living
 - e. For the betterment of their club, community, country, and world through positive community service, citizenship, and leadership.
- 3. Develop knowledge, attitudes, skills, and aspirations related to:
 - a. Leadership
 - b. Citizenship and Service
 - c. Communications, Promotion, and Public relations
 - d. Scholarship
 - e. Personal areas of interest
- 4. Participate in the Richland County 4-H Ambassador Training Program. *If you are a returning Ambassador, you will be expected to help lead this training.*
- 5. Assist with Richland County 4-H events. Possible activities include: Serve as emcees, planning committee members, and assisting with 4-H events (i.e., Richland County Fair, June Dairy Day, National 4-H Week, 4-H Recognition Banquet, Parades, 4-H Open House, Culver Share Night, 4-H Project Days, School Promotions and more! We would love to hear your ideas on how to promote 4-H!).
- 6. Assist as needed in planning, implementing, and evaluating county 4-H programs.
- 7. Represent Richland County 4-H on statewide committees. (Optional)
- 8. Work with other Richland County 4-H Ambassadors to plan, implement, and evaluate an Ambassador project to strengthen, promote, and publicize the Richland County 4-H youth development program.

Application Procedures and Selection Criteria

To apply, 4-H members need to complete a Richland County 4-H Ambassador application form and Endorsement of Applicant form. Also submit two (2) recommendations (using the recommendation forms supplied). Return to:

Extension Richland County Attn: 4-H Ambassador Program 1000 Hwy 14 W Richland Center, WI 53581

Selections will be based on the applicants' ability to communicate their achievements in the areas of 4-H work, 4-H participation, 4-H citizenship, 4-H teaching leadership, office and committee leadership, and leadership and service other than 4-H. Applicants will also be asked for their ideas for promoting the Richland County 4-H Program.

Newly selected Ambassadors will be required to attend the 4-H Ambassador Orientation. Participation in the orientation is MANDATORY.

Application instructions for <u>NEW 4-H Ambassadors</u> and Jr. 4-H Ambassadors:

- ENDORSEMENT OF APPLICATION (on page 5).
- RICHLAND COUNTY 4-H AMBASSADOR RECOMMENDATION FORMS (on pages 6 & 7).
 - a. Two (2) recommendation forms need to be completed:
 - i. One recommendation form needs to come from someone affiliated with 4-H (4-H club leader, project leader, Jr. Leader advisor, etc.)
 - ii. One recommendation form needs to come from a **non** 4-H affiliate. (Teacher, community representative, youth group leader, etc.)
