



Tags are available at the Extension Office for \$3.00 each. NEW--A signed copy of the Meat Animal Sale rules is required to be turned in prior to picking up tags. Exhibitors must submit a separate MAS form for each species.

All pig exhibitors must complete Youth for the Quality Care of Animals (YQCA) and submit the certificate along with their Education Report by July 15th.

2023 Meat Animal Sale (MAS) Updates

There are several changes for the Meat Animal Sale this year. Here is a brief summary. For a complete list of changes see the Richland County Fair Book.

• The Meat Animal Sale will begin at 5:00 p.m. The Buyers Reception starts at 4:00 p.m.

- Exhibitors are encouraged to participate in showmanship for **ALL** of their livestock entries.
- Exhibitors of champion and reserve champion animals are not required to sell that animal if they have participated in showmanship for each market animal exhibited. If the exhibitor of a champion animal has not participated in showmanship for ALL of their market animal species, they will be required to sell the champion or reserve champion animal.
- The 5% commission will be charged on the amount the buyer pays (not the total sale price)

• NEW--Meat Animal Sale Acknowledgement form due July 15. The form, which must be signed by both the exhibitor and their parents/guardians, states that they are aware of all the Meat Animal Sale deadlines. A separate form is required for each species.
