



2025 Scholarship Program

This scholarship is available to any Richland County 4-H, FFA or resident who is attending or planning to attend a College, Vocational School, Technical School, Agriculture Short Course, or any institution of higher learning. Scholarships will be distributed at the discretion of the Richland County Beef Producers.

Selection will be based on the following criteria:

- Your involvement with the Richland County Beef Producers and the beef industry
- Leadership in school, community and agricultural activities
- Financial need
- Scholastic performance and achievement

The selection procedure:

- The selection committee is made up of members of the Richland County Beef Producers Board of Directors and the Extension-Richland County 4-H Educator
- No relatives of the applicants shall be allowed to be on the selection committee.
- Selection committee decisions are final.

Applications should be written legibly or typewritten. Additional sheets may be added if necessary. Applicants may apply every year but may receive no more than four awards. The scholarship will be awarded after the first semester grades are received by the treasurer of the Richland County Beef Producers. Checks will be payable to the recipient unless otherwise requested.

Applications are due to the Richland Co. Extension Office by March 1, 2025 at 4:30 p.m.
