- Since the participants in the Arts Festival are eligible to receive a Fair premium, they must be enrolled in the Richland County 4-H program. The Arts Festival is open to 4-H members in 3rd-13th grade. Cloverbuds (5K-2nd Grade) may only participate in the Small and Large Group Performance category.

- Participants in the Vocal, Instrumental and Dance categories are eligible to receive a Fair premium if they are enrolled in the 4-H project. Remember to include your performance(s) on your Richland County Fair entry form. (Due August 1) Public Speaking and Demonstrations are also eligible for Fair premiums, but do not require enrollment in the Communication Arts project.
- 4-H Clubs are encouraged to participate in the small and large group performances. They will receive participation ribbons, but will not be judged and will not be eligible for premiums.
- All performances eligible for Fair premiums will be recorded and judged after the event.
