- Recipient must be enrolled full time in a post-secondary educational program for a minimum of one year.
- Recipient must request the check from the Richland County 4-H Leaders Board/Extension Office.
- Checks can be requested after the first semester/term with proof of full-time enrollment for the second semester/term.
- Recipient must also provide a copy of first semester/term transcript with proof of good standing (2.0 or better GPA, or equivalent).

***** A recipient can be selected for the Buena Anderson Memorial Scholarship ONLY once.***

Selection

- Applicants will be interviewed by a selection committee.
- Only one scholarship per year will be given.
