Kathy Fanta and Cecile Haugh held an informal meeting with secretary Jennie Silver. We were updated about the status of hiring a new FLE. The county board has made efforts to hire, some have not met standards, one was approved but declined because it did not fill all his expectations.

Our finances were given much consideration. Our last financial report was \$983.04, however the remaining 2023 State Convention expenses still needing to be paid are approximately \$340 and our upcoming scholarship payment of \$500 will leave us approximately \$143 in checking. Therefore we will have to cash our certificate of deposit which is approximately \$1020 to remain solvent. It will also be necessary not to offer a scholarship in the 2024 budget.

Our county is scheduled to host the fall district meeting, at a date to be determined. Cecile is assigned to get a speaker which will then determine the date for the meeting. The date will be October 15, 2024.




Our Richland County HCE Cultural Arts show was held at Schmitt Woodland Hills on July 16, 2024.
